



Blue Theology Registration Guidelines

- Registration fees are location-dependent. Pacific Grove and Newport Beach (CA) are \$450/person, Texas City (TX) is \$350/person, and the Beaufort (NC) site is \$800/person.
- A twenty-five percent deposit is required to reserve your groups' dates.
- 50% payment should be made 2 weeks prior to arrival. Remainder due on arrival. Confirmation will be emailed upon receipt of payment.
- There is a limit of 25 youth/chaperones that can register per visit. The adult chaperone (i.e. teacher, education/guidance counselor, or parent) must pre-register all youth in their group and will be responsible for obtaining release of liability form for each youth prior to visit.
- Registration includes:
 - Accommodations up to six (6) nights
 - Use of kitchen and dining facilities
 - Planned program of spiritual enrichment associated with a serving learning experience in Ocean stewardship.
 - Program includes complimentary admission and a tour of the aquarium, materials for crafts, merch, BBQ dinner with the elders, and other activities.
- Chaperones (adults at least 5 years older than the youth members) are responsible for safeguarding group property, youth supervision and discipline during the entire visit. We recommend a chaperone to student ratio of 1:4. The youth group must be chaperoned at all times. Please ensure that your group arrives on time and attends all scheduled events and pre-arranged functions.
- You are required to have your own transportation the entire length of your stay. Parking at the church is available.
- Cancellations: In the event that a registered youth or chaperone is not able to attend, the visiting group may substitute with an alternate youth or chaperone, but you must ensure that Blue Theology is notified in writing. If your group must cancel your reservation, please notify us in writing immediately so that we can open the space to another group.
